## 'Countrywatch'

Surrey Police have set up a new SMS text alert system for all members of our rural community. The scheme which is free to join, is aimed at all of the rural community which incorporates, Farmers, Gamekeepers, Farm workers, stables, Feed supplies, Fisheries and landowners. Countrywatch provides you with alerts sent direct to your mobile phone, with any incidents reported to Surrey Police within Mole Valley and surrounding areas.

If a theft or suspicious vehicle is reported then an instant text alert with relevant details will be send to you. Likewise we hope to be able to get information from you and assistance with sightings and reporting of suspicious activity.

As newly appointed Rural affairs officer, I felt it was important to keep you informed of emerging or recurring crime trends and to find a better way of communicating with you all. The scheme works in two ways, firstly keeping you all informed and helping you to protect your property and secondly to help us with obtaining information to build a better picture of rural crime to help us tackle it more effectively.

The more people that sign up to the scheme the more impact it will have. I will also be supplying signs to put up around your land advertising that you are part of Surrey Police's Countrywatch scheme. Hopefully this should act as a deterrent to would-be thieves! There are similar successful schemes running in Norfolk, Kent and Sussex and I genuinely believe that this will help fight crime, outside the realms of CCTV!
